FEEDING INSTRUCTIONS:

Pigs should have access to clean, fresh water at all times. Make feed changes gradually, over at least a 5 day time period. Never feed any feedstuffs that are moldy, musty or suspect in any way. Mix as directed below and feed as the sole ration.
